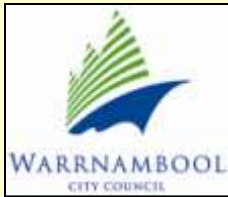




FRIENDS OF SWAN RESERVE Inc. NEWSLETTER

The Friends of Swan Reserve have been successful in getting a grant via the Warrnambool City Council's Community Development Fund. The grant for the amount of \$2772 will be utilised for the construction and installation of 3 picnic tables with seating. At present there is only one seat in the reserve and it is hoped that the new tables will encourage the general public to make more use of the area. The



friends group will be working with Warrnambool Men's Shed who will provide in-kind support in the form of labour to construct and erect the tables.

We have also just received confirmation that our funding application to Warrnambool City Council's Environment Fund has also been approved. This project is to construct a new Endangered Species—Waterwise garden bed complete with educational signage as per the original design by Tim Nicholas. We thank the Warrnambool City Council for their support.
